

SELECTION OF SEITZ FILTER SHEET GRADES For Beer

Seitz Filter Sheet Grade	Nominal Micron Retention Rating*	Suggested Uses for Beer Filtration
K900 or K1500	9-10	Rough - Polishing filtration or for dark beer
K800	7-8	Rough - Polishing filtration for dark beers
K700	5-7	Polishing to occasionally very slight haze filtration for amber and light-colored beers
K300	3-4	Polishing-bright beer filtration. Most common Seitz grade used by brewpubs and for keg beer.
K250	2-3	Bright beer filtration
K200	2.0	Bright beer filtration
K150	1.5	Bright beer filtration
K100	1.0	Bright beer filtration
KS80	0.8	Beginning of grades for sterile filtration. This grade for yeast-sterile filtration.
KS50	0.5	Grade for cold-sterile bottling filtration. Most common Seitz grade used for this purpose.
EK	0.45	A slightly tighter grade cold-sterile bottling filtration
